

PROPERTY HIGHLIGHTS




FELLOWS HALL

- Two distinct restaurant opportunities adjacent to Culinary Dropout and the Grand Gimeno event space on Orange Street
- Proposed common area restrooms and façade upgrades
- Ample public and street parking. The existing Lemon Street parking structure has approximately 608 parking stalls
- Within walking distance of Chapman University with an estimated 10,000 students.
- Restaurant #1: Approximately 3,109 SF of interior space with an opportunity for two patios totaling 2,588 SF (can be combined)

Restaurant #2: Approximately 2,190 SF of interior space with 507 SF of patio seating (can be combined)


